If additional forms are needed, make copies of all the forms. ONE OWNER per form and ONE HORSE per form. NO HORSE may be entered on more than one Form. Owners that have horses with several trainers will be required to pay an office fee per horse per trainer.
- **SIGNATURES REQUIRED** - Every Owner, Exhibitor, Trainer & Rider/Driver/Handler, or his/her agent(s) MUST sign the second page of the entry form and third page that contains the USEF WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY form. In the case of a Rider/Driver/Handler under 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign the entry blank on minor's behalf. Junior exhibitors are not eligible to sign as trainers, an adult MUST sign.
- **FARM NAME** may be used if the stable or farm is the bona fide owner appearing on the horse's registration papers. The owner must have an AHA Business membership and that owner AHA number must be used. The owner must have an active USEF Farm/Business ID# and one of the owners must be a current USEF member. Copies of AHA Business membership card, USEF Farm/Business ID# must be submitted with the entry.
- **INCLUDE** copies of REGISTRATION PAPERS for each horse entered.
INCLUDE copies of current AHA COMPETITION Membership cards for ALL Trainers, Riders, Handlers, Drivers, Junior Owners, and Riders AND at least one current owner.
INCLUDE copies of current USEF Membership cards with **SAFE SPORT CERIFICATION** for EVERY Owner, Trainer, Rider, Handler, and Driver & Junior Rider.
- Horses entered in AMATEUR OWNER and JUNIOR OWNER classes must be registered in the name of competitor or member of competitor's family. Leased horses are not eligible.
- **SHOWING NON-FAMILY CO-OWNED HORSES RULE** - *TWO DISTINCT NON-FAMILY OWNERS' MAY CO-OWN AND SHOW A HORSE IN JOTR or AOTR classes except that no family member or a professional may enter this relationship. Non-family is defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family. Horse must be registered as an "**AND**" ownership relationship, not "OR". **Both co-owners of horse must have current USEF Amateur membership.** No Farm or Corporation co-owned horses are eligible (see USEF AR110 4e)
- **SAFE SPORT TRAINING REQUIREMENT** (USEF members) If you are 18 years of age or older, you are required to complete the Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership. If you do not complete the training, you are ineligible to participate in all USEF competitions. Go to USEF.org - log onto your member dashboard and complete the SAFE SPORT TRAINING course. **Please include a copy of your current USEF membership card with Safe Sport Training completion dates** or send a copy of your Certificate of Completion of Safe Sport Training with your entries. All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport Training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org
- **USEF SHOW PASS** – **new Rule.** A Show Pass is available for riders, drivers, handlers, lungers, owners, lessees, and agents ONE TIME ONLY per Competition Year - application can only be done online at www.usef.org/show-pass. BREEDING/IN-HAND HALTER CLASSES - ALL Breeding & In-Hand Regional Championship classes will be judged using the COMPARATIVE JUDGING SYSTEM and IN THE RING CLASS PROCEDURE. The final placing for Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Five will be determined by the Majority Opinion System (MOS). Horses shall enter the arena in a Posted Order by birth date, oldest to youngest.

PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES – All Performance Halter Regional classes will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card. Participating in that one recognized class in that section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one Regional Championship Show of your choice. Participate in two AHA Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many Regional Championship Shows in that section. Equitation is based on the rider and the rider must participate in their qualifying section. Participation can also be used to qualify in Specialty classes and can be obtained through Open Shows.

Stalls will not be available until **THURSDAY AUGUST 22nd 7:00 AM** and **MUST** be vacated by **SUNDAY September 1st** by 12:00 noon. **NO HORSE IS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS BEFORE AUGUST 22 (7:00 am)**. Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. All stalls have full doors. **EXHIBITORS WISHING TO BE STABLED TOGETHER MUST SUBMIT THEIR ENTRIES IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.** Information provided on **STABLE WITH LINE** on the entry form will be considered but **NO GUARANTEES** can be made if not submitted in the same envelope. 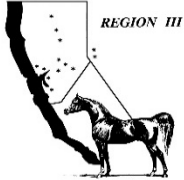

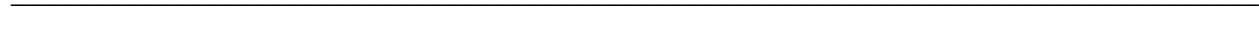

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD POINTS – This show is recognized by the AHA enabling exhibitors to receive Achievement Award Points in all USEF approved classes.

ADMISSION TO RING - No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, show officials and their assistants. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. **PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED** in any class requiring grooms or assistants to enter the ring,

AGE OF HORSES - For horse show purposes, any horse shall be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A JUNIOR horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT – EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND THE AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT THE AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT THE AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. CONDITION OF ENTRIES – See AR105 for Conduct, Specifications, Soundness and Welfare of the Horse. All entries, except entries in equitation and showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. All horses must be in good condition. See AR105.2 Natural Arabian Appearance - No horse may compete in a class in the Arabian Division with a tail carriage that has been altered in any manner or by any means. Violations of this rule are considered serious infractions because such alterations constitute misrepresentation of the breed type.

CENTER RING - No one is allowed in the center ring except judges, officials, and staff. When the arena is open for schooling of horses, the center ring area (including tables, couches, chairs, etc.) is CLOSED to all exhibitors, trainers, friends, and family.

CLASS CONFLICTS – Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes or two rings at the same time. Due to full schedules, gates will NOT be held for riders with conflicting schedules in two rings. No refunds will be given for ring conflicts or class conflicts. Plan your class schedule very carefully.

CRUELTY AND ABUSE - USEF GR838 & AR105 will be strictly enforced at all AHA competitions.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler, or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler, or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DISQUALIFICATION - Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly, or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statement regarding any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing, or exhibiting. In case any animal is disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal and the lowest moneyed prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.

DOGS - Dogs may be brought onto the show grounds but must always be on a leash. Dogs will not be allowed in ARENAS, REST ROOMS and OFFICES. Dog owners MUST clean up after their dogs. Dogs left unattended in the barn area, RV parking area, parking lot, etc. that BARK and/or DISTURB other exhibitors or guests will be asked to be removed from the grounds. Always keep dogs under control and be considerate of others.

DRUGS & MEDICATIONS – For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee. Horses at recognized competitions are subject to examination, which may include physical, saliva, urine or blood tests or any other test or procedure at the direction of said license tester. The exhibitor must file an official Equine Drugs & Medications Report Form with the Show Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours. The official Drugs/Medication Report Form is available online, from the officiating Show Steward or Designated Competition Representative.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES — Electronic communication devices used for the purpose of coaching, etc. between competitors and individuals outside the ring, shall be prohibited in all classes in the Arabian Division. Handicapped riders who have submitted written proof to the USEF Steward are exempt from the rule.

EQUINE VACCINATION RULE - All horses entering Nevada are required to have a Veterinary Health Certificate and Coggins Test. Horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF Rule Book GR845 for complete details and vaccine documentation form.

FARRIER - The show farrier will be available on the show grounds during all scheduled sessions. The show farrier will also be available Saturday 8/24 approximately 9:00 a.m. for pre-show farrier work. Appointments recommended.

GATE RULE - When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning may be issued. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed, and judging will commence. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY.** No protests will be upheld based on a public address system malfunction.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HALF ARABIAN / ANGLO ARABIAN COLTS / STALLIONS – Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian stallions registered with AHA or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit are permitted to compete in the AHA performance classes for Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian stallions may compete in their corresponding Sport horse In Hand Classes and may compete in Sport Horse performance classes for Half Arabian & Anglo-Arabian horses. Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian colts/stallions may compete in weanling and yearling Breeding/ In-Hand classes for geldings and in Sport Horse In-Hand classes.

HEADGEAR – All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEA) in any division or class without penalty from the judge. *Affirmation of the United States Equestrian Federation Helmet/Vest Rule GR801.4 Dress -Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear(ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES - All entries are accepted with the understanding that **REGION III of AHA, RSCVA and Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center (and their corporate owners, officers, agents, servants, landlord, and employees)** will not be held responsible from occurrences as to bodily injury liability and property damage liability relating to the event. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify REGION III of AHA, RSCVA and the RENO-SPARKS LIVESTOCK EVENTS CENTER, against any and all loss, damages & liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any & all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions set forth herein.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & WAIVER FOR RENO-SPARKS LIVESTOCK EVENTS CENTER

All exhibitors entering the Region III Arabian Championship Show held at Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center agree to the following: **“I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS RSCVA and Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center, their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and the insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to a “Parties Released”), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of RSCVA, RSLEC or their Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against RSCVA or RSLEC or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in equestrian activities at RSLEC. I will pay for all fees, damages, and costs, including attorney fees that RSCVA, RSLEC or other Parties released may incur in the enforcement of this agreement.”**

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS - To be eligible, riders must not have reached their **19th** birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date. Junior exhibitors (18-year-olds) will have to take out an adult membership with USEF and they must declare if they are an amateur or pro as defined by USEF. If they fall under the definition of a pro, then they can no longer compete in the Junior exhibitor classes since they are no longer considered amateurs according to GR106, even though they are still by AHA definition a Junior exhibitor. Junior exhibitors 18 years or older must complete SAFE SPORT TRAINING with 30 days of activating their USEF membership.

REMEMBER – HORSES ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY

GENERAL INFORMATION

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee USEF Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

LEVELING INFORMATION - The eligibility of the exhibitor as a SELECT / CHOICE / ELITE RIDER in a section (See AHA Rulebook Chapter 12, REG 121 for complete details) on **December 1** will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Primetime class is open to AHA members which are USEF/EC Amateurs 50 years of age or older and may participate in all disciplines. To find the rider level, go to www.arabianhorses.org, login in, click on Horse/Rider Points & Competition Records, click on Leveling Achievement Record, & search Rider Name.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES (Golf Carts, Mopeds, 3-Wheel Vehicles, Minibikes) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles if they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will cause sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule.

OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION - An Amateur Owner Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, driver or handler is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. "Family" includes husband, wife, parent, stepparent, child, brother, stepchild, sister, half-brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, and in-laws of the same relation as stated. Combined ownership is NOT permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. LEASED horses are NOT eligible.

SHOWING IN AMATEUR/OWNER CLASSES - Horses entered in an Amateur Owner or Junior Owner class MUST be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family (as defined by USEF GR123). Horses registered in a farm/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contract or Bill of Sale will NOT be accepted. (Exception – two nonrelated owners may show in Amateur/Owner class (see below).

TWO UNRELATED OWNERS SHOWING IN OWNER CLASSES – Two non-related owners listed on registration papers will be able to show in Owner Classes. Ownership MUST be an "AND" relationship (not an OR relationship). Co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals (no farms or business entities). No family member or a professional may enter this relationship. Family members of these two co-owners are NOT permitted to show in owner classes. BOTH owners must have current USEF membership & Amateur Certification.

PADDOCK EDIQUETTE FOR BREEDING/IN-HAND HALTER CLASSES - One person may assist with entrance of in-hand horses into the ring and will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted (Rule AR114.2). The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc. to make any noise. In addition, effective immediately, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with the entrance(s) into the arena.

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES - A copy of the current registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with the entry form at the time of making an entry.

ARABIAN HORSES shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if less than one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

HALF ARABIAN/ANGLO ARABIAN HORSES shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit; or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry & registration applied for and be entered under their full registered name.

RULES - This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation, Chapter AR Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted & judged in accordance therewith. The Show Committee shall decide questions that are not addressed by USEF Rules and their decision is final.

SAFE SPORT REQUIREMENT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport Training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

SCRATCHING OR CANCELING CLASSES - As a courtesy to the gateman, announcer & show office, the exhibitors are requested to notify the gateman and show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class entered. This courtesy will enable the show to run more efficiently. *Your consideration is appreciated!*

STALLIONS - Ladies and junior exhibitors in any class in this show may show Arabian stallions except in Showmanship, Walk Trot and Lead Line. Unruly horses in any class will be promptly dismissed.

US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION STATEMENT - Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. Effective 2/1/23

USEF SHOW PASS is available online ONLY at www.usef.org/show-pass for riders, drivers, handlers, lungers, owners, leases, and agents. The show pass cannot be applied for at the show. Trainers and coaches are no longer eligible to participate under a Show Pass and must be an Active USEF Member. Any parent or coach signing for their minor child must be an Active USEF member.

GENERAL INFORMATION

USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS - Copies of every owner's, trainer's, rider's, driver's and breeding/In-hand halter handler's current USEF Membership Cards must be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. A non-member who wishes to participate as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, lunger, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer at a Regular Competitions must be an active USEF member. In the event of multiple ownership of a horse, only one owner needs be a member. (Exception: see USEF AR 110 4e 1-11 regarding non-family co-owned horse. Both co-owners of horse MUST have current USEF Amateur membership). . Senior Active Member is those Members who are at least 18 years of age. Annual dues are \$80.00. Junior Active Members are those Members who have not reached their 18th birthday as provided for in GR127 and their annual dues are \$80.00.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION – Only active Federation members may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess the current amateur status issued by the Federation. There is no additional fee for amateur status for Senior Active or Life Members.

VETERINARIAN - A veterinarian will be present throughout the show & will be available on the grounds during all scheduled sessions. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. No veterinarian other than the official show veterinarian will be permitted to treat, medicate, or attend to a horse on the grounds. Anyone wishing to use another veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian on the grounds must obtain permission from Show Management.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

These classes will be held individually at the Region III Championship Show. The show committee will annually review the Maturity Rules. Entries will be shown and be judged by the Region III Show Rules. All rules not covered by this document will be governed by USEF rules.

ELIGIBILITY

All entries must be registered with the AHA or CAHR. There is no requirement for Owner's state of residence. Hunter Pleasure and Western Pleasure horses to be 5 years of age or under.

PERFORMANCE MATURITY FEES

Performance Maturity entry fees must be received on or before the closing date of Region III Championship Show. Nominations may be transferred upon sale of a nominated horse. The show secretary must receive notice of sale within two weeks of the date of sale. Horses may enter more than one class. There will be no vet-outs, refunds, or substitutions. Post entries will be accepted with penalty as listed in the Region III premium booklet.

The Nomination fee does not include show entry fees, drug fees, stall fees, etc. The Nomination entry fee into the Performance Maturity class does not constitute entry into the Regional Show. The Regional Show Entry form must be submitted with the appropriate entry fees prior to the close of entries in order for the horse to be shown in the specified Performance Maturity Classes.

DECLARATION OF CLASS

Class entry into a Performance Maturity class shall constitute specific division and class to be shown and may not be changed after your entries have been processed by the show.

PRIZE MONEY & AWARDS

Regional Awards will be given to an unrated full Top Five followed by Champion and Reserve Champion. All money received from nominations will be allocated for Prize Money. Nominations credited toward specific class entered. Prize Money divided:

5 or more entries: Champion 45%, Reserve 22%, Top 5 receive 11% each
4 entries: Champion 50%, Reserve 25%, remaining Top 5 receive 12.5% each
3 entries: Champion 55%, Reserve 30%, remaining Top Five entry 15%
2 entries: Champion 60%, Reserve 40%

TACK AND APPOINTMENTS

HUNTER PLEASURE

Junior hunter horses require a snaffle bit. (Snaffle bit is defined as snaffle bit of at least 3/8" diameter as measured 1/2" from the ring. The snaffle bit may be jointed, double jointed or unjointed. For all junior horse performance classes, all snaffle bits must have a round, egg butt or "D" shaped ring with no attachments to the headstall or reins through a hook (except for keepers for a full cheek snaffle when section rules allow a full cheek). Full cheek (with or without keepers), French and Dr. Bristol snaffle bits are permitted). The following are not permitted: ornamented bridles, browbands or cavessons, saddle seat style colored browbands/cavessons, figure eight, drop, or flash nosebands. Breastplate or breast collar is optional. No martingales or tie-downs.

ATR Classes require a light show type bridle, browband and cavessons must be of hunter type. Snaffle, pelham, full bridle or kimberwicke bit acceptable.

WESTERN PLEASURE

ALL classes require a snaffle bit or hackamore. A standard snaffle bit is defined as a center jointed single, rounded, unwrapped, smooth mouthpiece of 5/16" to 3/4" diameter metal as measured from ring to 1" in from the ring with a gradual decrease to the center of the snaffle. The rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter of either loose type, eggbutt, dee, or center mounted without cheeks. If a curb strap is used it must be attached below the reins. A hackamore includes a bosal rounded in shape and constructed of braided rawhide or leather and must have a flexible non-metallic core, attached to a suitable headstall. No other material of any kind is to be used in conjunction with the bosal, e., steel, metal, or chains (Exception: smooth, plastic, electrical tape is acceptable if applied in a smooth, untwisted manner). Attached reins may be of hair, rope, or leather. Both hands must be visible to the judge. Two hands may be used on hackamore (bosal) and western snaffle reins. Junior Western Pleasure horses shown in either a hackamore or snaffle must never have been shown in any Arabian Competition/Division Western Pleasure event in a bridle (except trail, reining, reined cow horse, all ranch and working cow horse classes).

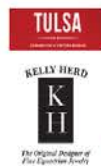
